Official Map Amendment to rezone approximately 0.14 acres of property located at 1628-1630 South Ogden Street from U-SU-C to U-TU-C in the Platt Park neighborhood.

1. Notice of receipt of the application was sent on August 6, 2024.
2. Notice for the Planning Board Public Hearing was sent on October 22, 2024.
3. Planning Board voted 6-1 to recommend approval of the application on November 6, 2024, with nine speakers offering public testimony at the Planning Board hearing.
4. Applicant contacted Council District 7 prior to submitting their application.
5. To date the applicant has provided 18 letters of support from the community.
6. To date staff has received 3 letters of support of the rezoning, and 32 letters in opposition, noting concerns with parking availability, impact on alley use and access by neighboring residents, and the possibility of setting a precedent for future single-unit to duplex rezonings in the area.
