A BILL

For an ordinance authorizing a capital equipment purchase from the Public Health State Grants Special Revenue Fund.

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health and Environment (DDPHE) is seeking approval to purchase a vehicle to support the Road to Recovery program funded from the "Criminal Justice Early Intervention Grant" program, which was approved via Resolution 951, Series of 2024; and

WHEREAS, said purchase will be authorized from the DDPHE "Criminal Justice Early Intervention" Grant program budget (14003-6500000); and

WHEREAS, said vehicle is over the \$50,000 threshold for capital equipment items that require City Council approval, per the Denver Revised Municipal Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From the Public Health State Grants Fund, Accounting No. 14003, the Executive Director of the Denver Department of Health Environment, or duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized to purchase or acquire the following capital equipment:

Section 2. The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
