The City and County of Denver Office of the City Forester (OCF) is seeking qualified contractors for on-call contract services related to tree maintenance throughout the City, including locations on public and private property

Purpose and Use of Agreements:

The purpose of the Maloney Tree Care On-Call contract is to establish On-Call General Tree Contractors available to respond to proposal bidding requests for the execution of the OCF 3-year work plan.

Services include tree pruning, tree removal, stump removal, stump grinding, filling of stump holes, and/or debris removal on public property, public rights-of-way, emergency tree work, including such work as necessary to resolve a violation of the Revised Municipal Code. Services were grouped into six groups, with some groups having subgroups and specific areas identified. Maloney Tree Care falls under the following group.

Group 6:	Public Right-of-Ways, Public Spaces and Private Property
	Subgroup 6C: Structural Tree Pruning of Young Trees on Public Right-of-Ways and Public Property

Contracts Description:

The contract has a three (3) year term and the amount is \$500,000.

- Maloney Tree Care, LLC (\$500K)

The contract does not commit funds, nor does it guarantee any amount to the firms. The contract is not an authorization of work. Authorization or work and commitment of funds are made via task notices on an as needed basis.
