A BILL

For an ordinance amending Sections 39-121 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver regarding the Schedule for Use of Facilities, specifically for the Denver Golf Enterprise Fund.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. Section 39-121(2), at subsection a., of the Denver Revised Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

~~“a. [Reserved] Annual fees: Unlimited play for Denver residents only (not good on Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays or holidays) includes reservation card...\$1,000.00
Plus, per round, 9 holes...7.00
Plus, per round, 18 holes...9.00
Effective July 21, 2008, no annual cards will be issued except to annual card holders who purchased an annual card the preceding year.”~~

Section 2. Section 39-121(2), at subsection b., of the Denver Revised Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

~~“b. Course fees: At City Park, Willis Case, Overland, Kennedy, Evergreen, and Wellshire Golf Courses, the following fees shall apply:~~

(f)	Junior, 18 holes	24.00 <u>35.00</u>	N/A

The fees listed above include a funding fee for the youth golf program. The department of parks and recreation shall use the money raised through the youth golf program funding fee to develop programs for Denver youths to learn and play golf.”
