A BILL

For an ordinance approving a proposed Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and School District No. 1 in the City and County of Denver and the State of Colorado, to create 2 FTE positions that will be dispatched to schools as needed to provide support to students who are at the beginning stages of substance misuse.
