**A BILL**

**For an ordinance making a rescission from and an appropriation in the Culture and Recreation Special Revenue Fund Series to make a cash transfer to Parks Legacy Capital Improvement Funds.**

**WHEREAS**, in 2018, Denver voters approved Ballot Measure 2A, which increased the sales tax rate by 0.25 percentage points starting January 1, 2019, to be spent on various programs and projects that support Parks, Trails and Open Space; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 0095, series of 2025 approves a Purchase and Sale Agreement to acquire 1060 South Emporia Street, located in Denver’s Windsor neighborhood; and

**WHEREAS**, said acquisition supports the goals and criteria of two Denver Parks and Recreation (DPR) acquisition focus areas of equity and a 10-Minute walk or roll, as identified in the Parks Legacy Fund Five Year Plan and DPR’s Strategic Acquisition Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to transfer cash from the Parks Legacy Special Revenue Fund to the Parks Legacy Improvement Projects Fund to be utilized for the acquisition of 1060 South Emporia Street;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** From appropriations heretofore made from the Culture and Recreation Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 15000, listed or indicated in the following tabulation there is hereby RESCINDED the amount listed or indicated in such tabulation under the heading "Amount Rescinded":
