5 **A BILL**

6 **For an ordinance authorizing a capital equipment purchase from the Climate**
7 **Protection Special Revenue Fund.**

9 **WHEREAS**, the Denver Police Department (DPD) is seeking approval for a capital
10 equipment purchase of two electric vehicles to support an interagency agreement between the
11 Office of Climate Action, Sustainability, and Resiliency (CASR) and the DPD for a pilot project that
12 will allow DPD to test using EV technology; and

13 **WHEREAS**, said purchase will be authorized from CASR’s “Climate Protection Special
14 Revenue Fund” (11880); and

15 **WHEREAS**, said vehicles are over the \$50,000 threshold for capital equipment items that
16 require City Council approval, per the Denver Revised Municipal Code;

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY**

21 **Section 1.** From the Climate Protection Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 11880, the
22 Executive Director of the Office of Climate Action, Sustainability, and Resiliency, or duly authorized
23 representatives, is hereby authorized to purchase or acquire the following capital equipment:

25 and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary
26 to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
