20	inflicted upon Indigenous Peoples throughout the Americas a	nd the subsequent forced removal from	
21	ancestral lands, and the deliberate and systematic destruction	on of Indigenous People, communities,	
22	and culture; resulting in high poverty rates, disparities in educ	ation, health and socioeconomic status;
