EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Platte to Park Hill Stormwater Systems Project (“Project”) is a comprehensive approach to better protecting people and property against flooding while improving water quality and enhancing public spaces. The Project is focused in the near-term on the northern neighborhoods of Elyria, Swansea, Cole, Clayton, Skyland, Whittier, Five Points and Northwest Park Hill. These areas are at risk of severe flooding during storms.

Four projects are part of the Project. Each specific project is being designed independently, and is part of a coordinated construction process to realize cost savings and project efficiencies, as well as ensure compatibility with other nearby improvements.

The Project will increase neighborhood connectivity, improve water quality, add new park and recreation spaces, as well as provide critical flood protection.
