# Denver Parks and Recreation Fee Proposal September 2016

#### Golf

- Last fee adjustment occurred in 2014
- Increases certain maximum green fee (applies to prime time play)
- Maintains Denver Golf's green fees in the lower end of comparable area courses
- Revenue is estimated to increase approximately \$250,000 annually
- Additional revenue will be use to address deferred maintenance and needed improvements

#### **Event Permitting**

- Eliminate application fee (replaced by change to payment terms)
- Eliminate rain date fee (replaced by new cancellation policy)

#### **Event facilities**

- Washington Park Boathouse & City Park Pavilion
  - o Eliminate different pricing structure between events with and without alcohol
  - o Increases prior "non-alcohol" fees to match "with-alcohol" fees
  - o Adds 7 hour morning rate at City Park Pavilion
  - o Retains 50% non-profit discount
  - Maintains Denver event facility fees at the bottom of comparable area venues
- Adds fees to the ordinance for the James Fleming Mansion

#### **Levitt Pavilion**

- Establishes permit fees for use of the Levitt Pavilion
- Fees only apply after 50 free concerts and 5 Levitt fundraising concerts
- Fees were calibrated using Arts and Venues fees for their venues

**Section 1.** That subsection 22 (Levitt Pavilion fees) of section 121 (Schedule for Use of Facilities) of Article IV (Fees and Charges) of Chapter 39 (Parks and Recreation) of the Revised Municipal Code shall be added to read as follows:

**39-121.** (22) Levitt Pavilion fees: The following are the fees payable for the commercial or community rental of the Levitt Pavilion at Ruby Hill Park:
