Section 1. That the Park Property, known as Sand Creek Open Space, is hereby designated as a "park" under section 2.4.5 of the City Charter and shall henceforth be regarded as being a designated park in the City and County of Denver, the designation being subject to existing maintenance facilities and a nursery/storage area operated by the Department of Parks and Recreation, existing Metro Wastewater sewer lines, an existing Denver Water Department water facilities site, the drainage for Sand Creek, and any existing utilities lawfully located in the Park Property as of the date of this park designation.
