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CONTRACT DESCRIPTION



- To provide Shuttle Bus System services to DEN for the transportation of the airport's public passengers and employees
- The agreement provides for the management, operation, maintenance, provision of buses, and any related services to support the Shuttle Bus System

SELECTION PROCESS



- Contractor was selected through RFP process in 2016
- Two proposals were received
- Previous incumbent AMPCO System Parking now known as ABM Parking Services
- Selection Criteria: Best qualified and pricing
- Successful proposer is ABM Parking Services
 - ABM Parking Services is a national company with a local office in Denver
 - They employ approximately 240 employees

CONTRACT TERMS AND AMOUNT



- The term is five years with two options for one-year extension
- The contract amount is \$178,000,000

BUSINESS CASE SUMMARY



- The RFP process provided DEN with competitive pricing
- Contractor provides all buses and is required to maintain the buses
- Contract provides DEN savings in equipment and maintenance cost
- Contract term provides DEN with cost effective pricing of the buses
- Buses fueled by clean natural gas and are environmentally friendly

GOALS



- The Division of Small Business Opportunity determined on February 9, 2016 that this contract's scope of services does not fall under provisions of Denver's Construction Empowerment Initiative Ordinance.
- The RFP encouraged M/WBE participation
- ABM Parking Services proposed 14.96% subcontractor participation.
- ABM Parking Services proposed 7.0% M/WBE, ACDBE, DBE participation
