Ordinance Request

Appropriate \$500,000 from Capital Improvement Fund 2016 contingency to support the rehabilitation of the building located on the Sand Creek Open Space.





Sand Creek Open Space

- Acquired and designated officially by Parks in 2016.
- City owns and maintains buildings on Sand Creek Open Space.
 - Buildings are utilized by The Urban Farm for agricultural and environmental education to metro Denver youth and children
 - Average 5,400 visitors per year



CIP Contingency Request

- CIP contingency is needed to support the critical rehabilitation of structures.
 - Life/safety improvements
 - Environmental remediation
 - ADA improvements
- Funds will be used to bring the facility up to current standards for housing educational programs including current ADA and life safety codes.
