



#### A BILL

FOR AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE EAST AND WEST FURLIC ALLEY LYING BETWERN THE SOUTH LINE OF LOT 56 AND THE MORTH LINE OF MARION SQUARE IN BLOCK 26, PARK AVENUE ADDITION TO LENVER, IN THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

WHEREAS, WALTER B. LOWRY, Manager of Improvements and Parks did heretofore make the following order, to-wit:

"It is hereby found and determined that the public use, convenience and necessity do not now require,

The East and West public alley lying between the South line of Lot 36 and the North line of Marien Square in Block 26, Park Avenue Addition to Denver, in the City and County of Denver, in the State of Colorado, be and the same hereby is macated.

And the Council of the City and County of Denver is hereby requested to give effect to this order by the passage of a suitable ordinance.

(Signed) Walter B. Lowry

## NOW, THEREFORE

Section 1: That the action of the Manager of Improvements and Parks as above set forth, be and the same is, hereby ratified, approved and confirmed.

Section 2: That, the East and West public Alley lying between the South line of Lot 36 and the North line of Marion Square in Block 26; Park Avenue Addition to Denver, in the City and County of Denver, in the State of Colorado, be and the same hereby is vacated, reserving to the City and County of Denver at all times the right to construct, maintain and remove sewers, water pipe and appurtenances and to authorize the construction, maintenance and removal of the same therein and therefrom, and subject to the continued right of the owners to maintain and operate existing Electric Light and Power Lines, Telephone Lines, Gas mains and pipes.

Section 3: In the opinion of the Council this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and public safety and shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and final publication.
