A BILL

For an ordinance re-appointing Julia C. Yeckes to serve as a member of the Board of Ethics.

WHEREAS, Sec. 2-53(a)(3) of the Code of Ethics requires Denver City Council to appoint two members of the Board of Ethics; and

WHEREAS, Sec. 2-53(c)(4) of the Code of Ethics requires appointees to be nominated by the Board of Ethics Nominations Committee which has recommended Ms. Yeckes reappointment; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-53(d)(1) of the Code of Ethics states that the terms of members shall be four years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That the Council of the City and County of Denver hereby reappoints Julia C. Yeckes to serve as a member of the Board of Ethics for a term beginning immediately and ending, April 20, 2021.
