

#### **Tapiz Apartments (1099 Osage)**


- 100 senior/disabled apartments
- 40%-50%-60% AMI
- Osage Café operated by Youth Employment Academy
- Youth arts classes / studio space
- Community-accessible computer room
- Financed with \$3M City funds

### DHA HQ (1095 Osage)

- Mercado at Mariposa grab'n'go café facing 10<sup>th</sup> and Osage light rail stop
- Collaborative office space for nonprofits and small business startups

DHA requests to move the lot line that separates Tapiz Apartments (1099 Osage) from DHA HQ site (1095 Osage)





# **PROJECT DETAILS**



#### **Amendment Needed**

- 6,000 sf of community gardens and parking to be relocated
- No material impact on City's security interest
- Amendment needed to release 6,000 sf from City's Deed of Trust





# **NEED FOR CITY ACTION**



#### **Expeditious Action Requested:**

- \$32.5M in New Markets Tax Credits (NMTC)
- Yields \$11.6M equity investment
- 30% of HQ structure construction cost
- HUD approval requires City approval
- NMTC investors/lenders close July 2017
