7	For an ordinance increasing the hourly rate compa-ratio for part-time County		
8	Court magistrates and amending the benefits received by full-time County		
9	Court magistrates to allow 10 days of paid time off benefits to be carried over

12	WHEREAS, Section 14-109, Denver Revised Municipal Code, governs the salary and		
13	benefits of county court magistrates; and		
14	WHEREAS, City Council has determined that the hourly rate paid to part time county court		
15	magistrates should be increased to be equal to a compa-ratio of .972; and		
16	WHEREAS, City Council has determined that full time county court magistrates should be		
17	allowed to carry over 10 hours of paid time off from year to year.		
18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY		
19	OF DENVER:		
20	Section 1. This ordinance shall become effective August 1, 2017.		
21	Section 2. That subsection (b) of Section 14-109, Denver Revised Municipal Code, is		
22	hereby amended by deleting the language stricken and adding the language underlined, to read as		
23	follows:		
24	(b)	Each part time county court magistrate shall b	e paid an hourly rate equal to a compa-
25		ratio of 0.832 0.972 of the pay grade applicable	e to the job classification entitled
26		"Assistant City Attorney – Senior" in the legal	occupational group in the classification
27		and pay plan adopted and maintained in acco	rdance with chapter 18, division 2 of
28		Article II.	
29	Section 3. That subsection (c) of Section 14-109, Denver Revised Municipal Code, is		
30	hereby amended by deleting the language stricken and adding the language underlined, to		
31	read as follows:		
32	(c)	Except as otherwise provided in this subsection	on (c), full time county court magistrates
33		shall receive benefits paid to or on behalf of en	mployees by the city, in an amount not
34		to exceed the amount established by this chap	oter for career service employees. In

1	lieu of receiving paid sick leave and paid vacation leave, full time county court			
2	magistrates may receive paid time off in an amount not to exceed twenty-five (25)			
3	days per year, and to carry over from year to year up to ten (10) days of paid time off			
4	each year, but shall not be entitled to carry over such time off from year to year or to			
5	receive payment for accrued time off upon termination or retirement from			
6	employment with the city. The presiding judge of the county court shall administer the			
7	paid time off program for county court magistrates and may promulgate additional			
8	rules for the administration of the program.
