A BILL

For an ordinance approving the execution of a Sewer Use and Drainage Permit between the City and County of Denver and Pinehurst Animal Center, to provide sanitary sewer and/or wastewater services to property located outside City limits.

WHEREAS, the proposed Sewer Use and Drainage Permit between the City and County of Denver and Pinehurst Animal Center, as owner of 6500 W. Hampden Avenue of Jefferson County, cannot be executed by the proper officials of the City and County of Denver until after approval action or inaction by the Council of the City in accordance with Subsection 56-97(a)(4) of the Revised Municipal Code of the City, because the Sewer Use and Drainage Permit provides for the carriage of wastewater of a person or entity outside the geographical limits of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has duly reviewed the proposed Sewer Use and Drainage Permit;
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed Sewer Use and Drainage Permit between the City and County of Denver and Pinehurst Animal Center, as owner of 6500 W. Hampden Avenue of Jefferson County, in the words and figures contained and set forth in the form of Sewer Use and Drainage Permit filed in the office of the Clerk and Recorder, Ex-Officio Clerk of the City and County of Denver, under City Clerk's Filing No. 2017-0256 is hereby approved.
