CB17-0658 2 SERIES OF 2017 COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE: 3 Finance & Governance 4 A BILL 5 For an ordinance amending Ordinance No. 0050, Series 2016 relating to the 6 issuance of City and County of Denver, Colorado, Dedicated Tax Revenue 7 Refunding and Improvement Bonds, Series 2016A, and City and County of 8 Denver, Colorado, Dedicated Tax Revenue Refunding and Improvement Bonds, 9 Taxable Series 2016B. 10 11 WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver (the "City"), Colorado (the "State"), is a municipal 12 corporation duly organized and existing as a home rule city under Article XX of the State Constitution 13 14 and under the Charter of the City (the "Charter") and is a political subdivision of the State; and **WHEREAS**, all legislative powers possessed by the City, conferred by Article XX of the State 15 16 Constitution, except as limited by the Charter, as from time to time amended, or otherwise existing by operation of law are vested in a board of councilmen, also known as the City Council (the 17 "Council"); and 18 WHEREAS, the members of the Council have been duly elected, chosen and qualified; and 19 20 WHEREAS, on February 29, 2016, the Council adopted Ordinance No. 0050, Series 2016 (the "Bond Ordinance") authorizing the issuance of its Dedicated Tax Revenue Refunding and 21 Improvement Bonds, Series 2016A, and its Dedicated Tax Revenue Refunding and Improvement 22 Bonds, Taxable Series 2016B (collectively, the "Series 2016 Bonds"); and 23 WHEREAS, capitalized terms used herein and not otherwise defined shall have the meanings 24 25 set forth in the Bond Ordinance; and WHEREAS, the Council, in the name and on behalf of the City, has determined that it is 26 advantageous and in the best interest of the City and the inhabitants thereof to amend certain 27 provisions of Chapter 53 (Taxation and Miscellaneous Revenue) of the City's Revised Municipal 28 Code to replace the City's tax exemption for charitable and religious corporations with a new tax 29 exemption for non-profit organizations exempt under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3); and 30 **WHEREAS**, in connection with such proposed amendment to the City's Revised Municipal 31 Code, the Council, in the name and on behalf of the City, has determined that it is advantageous 32

and in the best interest of the City and the inhabitants thereof to amend certain provisions of the

Bond Ordinance as further set forth herein; and

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WHEREAS, the Bond Ordinance provides, in pertinent part, that the City may amend or modify any provision of the Bond Ordinance without the consent of or notice to any of the Owners of Series 2016 Bonds to effect any changes in the Bond Ordinance that, in the opinion of an attorney or firm of attorneys whose experience in matters relating to the issuance of obligations of states and their political subdivisions is nationally recognized ("Bond Counsel"), do not materially and prejudicially affect the rights of the Owners of any Series 2016 Bonds; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has received an opinion from Bond Counsel that the amendment to the Bond Ordinance set forth herein does not materially and prejudicially affect the rights of the Owners of any Series 2016 Bonds.

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

- **Section 1**. Section 805(B) of the Bond Ordinance is hereby amended and restated in its entirety as follows:
  - "B. So long as any of the Series 2016 Bonds authorized herein remain Outstanding, the City shall continue to impose, administer, enforce and collect the Pledged Excise Taxes and shall not take any action that reduces, impairs, or repeals the imposition, administration, enforceability and collectability of such Pledged Excise Taxes if such action would materially and prejudicially affect the rights of the Owners of any Series 2016 Bonds."
- **Section 2**. Except as amended herein, the Bond Ordinance shall remain as originally stated and is hereby ratified, approved and confirmed.
