## Comparing Crime related to Marijuana and Crime related to Liquor is very difficult

- In many cases parallel data simply does not exist
  - Crimes involving intoxication: either MJ or Liquor are not tracked
    - ▶ Domestic Violence, Assaults, Disturbances
- The differences on licensing requirements between liquor and marijuana businesses
  - Higher security requirements of Marijuana establishments
  - MJ Licenses can be co-located
- For this presentation, we are comparing:
  - Age Compliance Violations
  - Crimes associated with Retail Liquor Stores and Retail Marijuana Centers
  - Driving under the influence of Alcohol and Driving under the influence of Marijuana

# Driving Under and Influence of Alcohol vs. Driving under the Influence of Marijuana

- Permissible Inference 5NG According to the law, at this point you can infer that someone at this level MAY be under the influence of Marijuana, which is different than a Per Se on a DUI
- ▶ 28 DREs (Drug Recognition Experts) citywide
- If alcohol and drugs are suspected, we will typically only test for alcohol
- A DUI arrest usually includes a stop, roadsides and blood or breath test. (this can be completed in about an 1-2 hours)
- A DUI/D requires a stop, roadsides, a 12-step exam and blood test. (this usually takes 2-4 hours minimum)
