17	WHEREAS, the Department of Finance, Risk Management requests a new fund to administer					
18	the Firefighter Heart Benefit program;

21	Section 1. A new fund is hereby established in the General Government Special Revenue					
22 23	Fund, Accounting No. 11000 a "Firefighter Heart Benefit" fund, Accounting No. 11864-2550000 for accounting for the receipt and expenditure of program dollars.					
24	Section 2. Monies received from the State of C					
25	of revenue including transfers from other City funds, shall be deposited into the Treasury of the					
26	City and credited to Special Fund No. 11000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of					
27	the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.					
28	Section 3. Program expenditures are hereby a	uthorized for the "Firefighter Heart Benefit"				
29	fund, Accounting No. 11864-2550000, in the amount	not to exceed the total deposits described in				
30	Section 2 of this Ordinance, to be expended by the Chief Financial Officer. Authorized					
31	expenditures will include a statutory award schedule to reimburse affected firefighters. This is a					
32	non-lapsing fund.
