However, the supply of food at the food bank had not increased. This experience focused my desire to help organization's achieve their goals. For more than 14 years, I have worked in the nonprofit sector with a key focus on social services. I now serve as the Founder and CEO of the Nonprofit Learning Lab, a national nonprofit that national nonprofit that connects, supports and develops individuals seeking to lead the nonprofit sector.

I am submitting this cover and application to serve on the Denver Commission of Strategic Partnerships.
