



More people riding transit


Improved passenger experience


Participants (workshops/events) indicated these priorities:



- Using the plan goals as drivers in how decisions are made




Major Transit Corridor Survey

Results

- 1,000+ responses
- Colfax received 525 overall votes for highest priority corridor
- Results help inform the evaluation of the corridors for potential capital investment


Please select the 5 corridors that you think should be a top priority for Denver.








Major Corridor Survey: Who Participated Focus Area Locations
