16	fund to include new vehicles;			
17	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF

19	Section 1. That Sections 1 of Ordinance No. 184 Series of 1992, is hereby amended to read			
20	as follows:			
21	"Section 1. The Planned Fleet fund (Accounting No. 11804) shall be used to			
22	accumulate monies for General Fund agencies for the acquisition of new and replacement			
23	vehicles and heavy equipment.			
24	Section 2. Monies are received from General Fund transfers, insurance proceeds,			
25	interest, and other sources, shall be deposited in the Treasury of the City, and credited to			
26	Special Fund No. 11000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised			
27	Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.			
28	Section 3. Expenditures include the purchase of new and replacement vehicles and			
29	heavy equipment. Expenditures are authorized in Accounting No. 11804, in the amount			
30	not to exceed the total of deposits described in Section 2 of this Ordinance, to be			
31	expended by the Executive Director of Public Works. This is a cash basis, non-lapsing			
32	fund.".
