The continued use of Comcast dark fiber resources for City and County of Denver data network transport. Comcast provides two fiber strands from 6 strategic hubs to approximately 100 City and County of Denver buildings. This new agreement gives the City the ability to add or delete sites as needed, continue to have high speed connections and enhance existing sites that are still on older technology. This fiber network is primarily used to transport voice, video and data services from the City's two datacenters. Today the primary end users are Safety sites, Police, Fire, and Sheriff Department.
