	Yes. This project is the subject of a lawsuit, <i>MacFarlane v. City and County of Denver</i> , 2016CV32126. The City has obtained a favorable ruling in the lawsuit at trial. The time to file for an appeal has not yet expired.	
	This project is part of the larger Platte to Park Hill project (P2P), which is also discussed in <i>Zeppelin v. Federal Highway Administration</i> , 17cv01661. However, the court in that case recently dismissed all claims relating to P2P and the City is no a defendant in that action.	t
	The P2P project has received criticism in the community.	
	The P2P project contemplates the temporary closing of the Park Hill Golf Course and the potential for future uses on the property which has received a negative reaction from some members of the community.
