The total 2017 mill levy for the affected funds is currently calculated off of this \$271,250,509:

Property Tax = Assessed Valuation x (Mill Levy/1000)


\$271,250,509 = Net A.V. x (Mill Levy/1000)

\$271,250,509 = 16,576,650,104 x (Mill Levy/1000)

Total 2017 Mill Levy for Affected Funds = 16.363






