- **Section 2.** That the City Council hereby finds that the public use and purpose described in Section 3 below will require the acquisition and use by the City of interests in a portion of the Parcel not to exceed a total of ninety (90) acres of land area (which land area is referred to herein as the "Property").
- **Section 3.** That the City Council hereby finds and determines that interests in the Property described in Section 2 are required for the following public uses and public purposes: to construct, locate, reconstruct, improve, modify, remove, and relocate storm water drainage, pipes, channels, detention areas, outfalls, and related facilities, systems and structures, and other appurtenant improvements, including the initial location and construction thereof (the "Project").
- **Section 4.** That the City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor, including his duly authorized representatives, in accordance with applicable federal, state, and local laws and rules and regulations adopted pursuant thereto, to (1) identify, survey and determine the specific location and configuration of the Property within the boundaries of the Parcel; (2) acquire the needed property interests in and to the Property, including, without limitation, fee title, beneficial title, permanent easements, temporary easements, fixtures, licenses, permits, leasehold interests, improvements, contract rights (including any beneficial, agency, or contract rights or interests in or to the Property arising under the Agency Agreement, dated October 13, 2000, and recorded in the real property records of the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado, on December 1, 2000, under Reception Number 2000175267), and any other rights, interests, and appurtenances thereto; (3) take all actions necessary to do so without further action by City Council, such as conducting negotiations, executing all related agreements, and making all necessary payments; (4) take actions required by law before instituting condemnation proceedings; (5) allow the temporary use and leasehold of City-owned land; and (6) convey City-owned land, including remnants.

Section 5. That if for the property interest set forth above, the interested parties do not agree upon the compensation to be paid for such needed property interests, the owner or owners thereof are incapable of consenting, the name or residence of any owner thereof is unknown, or any of the owners thereof are non-residents of the State of Colorado, then the City Attorney of the City, upon the Mayor's direction, is hereby authorized and empowered to exercise the City's eminent domain powers by instituting and, as necessary, prosecuting to conclusion proceedings under Title 38, Colorado Revised Statutes, to acquire any needed property interests upon, through, over, under and along the Property described in Section 2 above as necessary for the purposes set forth in Section 3 above. **Section 6.** That the City Council hereby finds and determines that the City's Department of Public Works and any federal and state agencies, if applicable, may find the need to alter the legal descriptions of the properties referred to in this Ordinance and may continue to do so in order to meet the needs of the Project. City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor, including his duly authorized representatives, in accordance with applicable federal, state, and local laws and rules and regulations adopted pursuant thereto, to acquire the Property as the legal descriptions are altered in accordance with the means authorized in this Ordinance. **Section 7.** That the City Council hereby finds and determines that the Project is necessary for the health, safety, and welfare of the public.
