For an ordinance establishing a new fund in the Community Development Special Revenue Fund for the "Affordable Housing Incentive Fee Fund".

WHEREAS, the Department of Finance requests a new fund for the "Affordable Housing Incentive Fee Fund" to support affordable housing programs in the City and County of Denver; and WHEREAS, expenditures from the "Affordable Housing Incentive Fee Fund" shall be made in accordance with the adopted comprehensive housing plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. A new fund is hereby established in the Community Development Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 16000, an "Affordable Housing Incentive Fee Fund", Accounting No. 16811 for the purpose of accounting for the receipt and expenditure of program dollars.

Section 2. Monies received from payments of incentive height linkage fees, other linkage fees, interest, and other sources of revenue including transfers from other City funds, shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 16000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3. Program expenditures are hereby authorized for the "Affordable Housing Incentive Fee Fund", Accounting No. 16811, in the amount not to exceed the total of deposits described in Section 2 of this ordinance to be expended by the Executive Director of the Office of Economic Development. Authorized expenditures include the production or preservation of rental housing, including the funding of rental assistance programs, for qualified households earning eighty (80) percent or less of AMI; the production or preservation of for-sale housing for qualified households earning one hundred (100) percent or less of AMI; homebuyer assistance programs, including down payment and mortgage assistance programs, for qualified households earning one hundred and twenty (120) percent or less of AMI; the development of permanent supportive housing for homeless persons and for "supportive services" associated with such housing; provided, however, in no event shall the amount expended from the "Affordable Housing Incentive Fee Fund" for "supportive services" exceed ten (10) percent of the balance in the fund on January

1	1 of each year; programs supporting low-income at-risk individuals in danger of losing their existing			
2	homes, for mitigation of the effects of gentrification and involuntary displacement of lower income			
3	households in those neighborhoods of the city that are most heavily impacted by rapidly escalating			
4	housing costs, for homeowner emergency repairs, or for other housing programs. Administrative			
5	expenses shall not exceed eight (8) percent of the balance of the fund on January 1 of each year			
6	This is a cash basis, non-lapsing fund.			
7	Section 4. The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized			
8	and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be			
9	necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
