For an ordinance amending Sections 39-121(c) of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver regarding the Schedule for Use of Facilities, specifically for the Denver Zoological Gardens.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. Section 39-121 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code is amended by revising subsection (c) to read as follows:
