A BILL

For an ordinance approving and providing for the execution of a proposed Intergovernmental Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the State of Colorado, Department of Transportation, concerning the "Federal Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) 2018 Package 2 City and County of Denver Traffic Signal Replacement " project and the funding therefor.

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed Intergovernmental Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the traffic signal improvements will be located at 38th Avenue and Federal Boulevard, Kentucky Avenue and Federal Boulevard, Mississippi Avenue and Federal Boulevard, Jewell Avenue, and Federal Boulevard and Colorado Boulevard and Martin Luther King Boulevard;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed Intergovernmental Agreement, under CFDA No. 20.205, between the State of Colorado, Department of Transportation, and the City and County of Denver, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 17-0554, be and hereby is approved in all respects.

Section 2. The payments made by the Colorado Department of Transportation to the City pursuant to and under the Intergovernmental Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 38000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3. That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said "Federal Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) 2018 Package 2 City and County of Denver Traffic Signal Replacement" project is as follows:


Authorization for expenditure of said funds following execution of said Contract will cover the period of five years from the effective date of execution of the contract, or project closeout whichever occurs sooner.
