For an ordinance vacating an alley between Bryant Street and Alcott Street and between 26th Avenue and 27th Avenue, subject to certain reservations.

WHEREAS, the Manager of Public Works of the City and County of Denver has found and determined that the public use, convenience and necessity no longer require that certain area in the system of thoroughfares of the municipality hereinafter described and, subject to approval by ordinance, has vacated the same with the reservations hereinafter set forth;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

25.

Section 1. That the action of the Manager of Public Works in vacating the following described area in the City and County of Denver and State of Colorado, to wit:

ALL OF THE ALLEY, LOCATED IN BLOCK 7, EMERY'S SUBDIVISION OF BLOCKS 5, 6, 7, 14, 15, 16, HIGHLAND; AS RECORDED IN BOOK 4 AT PAGE 8 IN THE RECORDS OF THE ARAPAHOE COUNTY, NOW CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER, SITUATED IN THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 29, TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 68 WEST OF THE 6TH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER, STATE OF COLORADO.

SAID PARCEL CONTAINS 8,634 SQUARE FEET OR 0.20 ACRES, MORE OR LESS.

be and the same is hereby approved and the described area is hereby vacated and declared vacated; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, said vacation shall be subject to the following reservations:

A perpetual, non-exclusive easement is hereby reserved by the City and County of Denver, its successors and assigns, over, under, across, along, and through the vacated area for the purposes of constructing, operating, maintaining, repairing, upgrading and replacing public or private utilities including storm drainage and sanitary sewer facilities and all appurtenances to said utilities. A hard surface shall be maintained by the property owner over the entire easement area. The City reserves the right to authorize the use of the reserved easement by all utility providers with existing facilities in the easement area. No trees, fences, retaining walls, landscaping or structures shall be allowed over, upon or under the easement area. Any such obstruction may be removed by the City or the utility provider at the property owner's expense. The property owner shall not re-grade or alter the ground cover in the easement area without permission from the City and County of Denver. The property owner shall be liable for all damages to such utilities, including their repair and replacement, at the property owner's sole expense. The City and County of Denver, its successors, assigns, licensees, permittees

1	and other authorized users shall not be liable for any damage to property owner's property due
2	to use of this reserved easement.
