EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The purpose of the ordinance is to approve a Service Plan after a public hearing at City Council for a new metropolitan district titled Boulevard at Lowry.

The District will provide for construction, financing, operation and maintenance of Public Improvements necessary to redevelop the site located near 1st and Quebec in the Lowry Redevelopment Plan area. The site is intended to support only commercial uses including a Lucky's Grocery Store, office, retail and restaurant. The district will be responsible for ongoing maintenance of public enhancements on the commercial site including lighting, planters, and a parking garage to serve the businesses as well as provide additional public parking for the Schlessman Library which is adjacent to the site. The site is part of the final Lowry development commonly known as Boulevard One.

State law requires a public hearing regarding the Service Plan and is scheduled for July 9th. The hearing has been noticed according to the Special District Act requirements and a presentation will be in Finance and Governance Committee on June 12th.
