- Purchased from Xcel in 2015 for \$50,000 (includes Westwood)
- Develop small pocket park (i.e. Ferguson "Turtle" Park)
- Funding to design and construct not immediately identified

 HM Capital approached DPR with offer to swap property and develop neighborhood park in 2016

- HM Capital's concept plan for mixed use adjacent to park with offer to design and construct public park
- DPR ultimately decided to accept a cash donation (\$650,000) and to lead the design and construction process
- GPH RNO initiates local design process

29TH AND FAIRFAX PARK


RNO Design Objectives

- Inviting space "Welcoming all residents"
- Meeting place for neighbors
- Quiet place to sit, talk, play games, picnic
- Kids play area with seating for parents
- Public green space for recreation, play, sitting, and events

DPR outreach confirmed this direction and concepts illustrated areas for play, gathering and passive use. Based on additional outreach, concept will be further refined.
