A BILL

For an ordinance making an appropriation to the Public Health and Wellness Special Revenue Fund.

WHEREAS, the Denver Department of Public Health and Environment seeks to increase the appropriation to the Public Health and Wellness Special Revenue Fund based on revenue received from an intergovernmental agreement with the Colorado Department of Transportation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From the Public Health Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 14000, out of monies not otherwise appropriated and in addition to amounts heretofore appropriated by Ordinance No. 1237, Series of 2017, and any supplemental appropriations or rescissions, there is hereby appropriated to the appropriation accounts hereinafter designated the amount of money following such designation, to be expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:

The aforementioned appropriation will be used for the Healthy Foods Challenge to facilitate access to fresh food in the Globeville and Elyria-Swansea Neighborhoods.

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Section 2. The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
