Attach executive summary if more space needed: In 2015, Denver voters approved the issuance of \$778 million of bonds to be repaid from dedicated taxes of the city, specifically a portion of lodgers, short-term car rental, and prepared food and beverage taxes. \$104 million of the authorization is for the expansion of the Colorado Convention Center, with \$674 million for the National Western Center project. In 2016, Denver issued \$242 million of bonds for these projects (\$6million for the Convention Center and \$236 million for the National Western Center). The National Western Center Project is progressing and the entire amount of this financing will provide the needed funding to construct improvements and prepare the land for development
