.2	(3) "Eligible employee" shall mean both: officers (elected and appointed) and employees of			
3	the city career service employees as defined in section 9.1.1(e) of the charter, and charter officers			
4	as defined in section 9.2.1 of the charter. The definition of eligible employee shall not include:			
.5	a. Part-time employees who are regularly scheduled to work less than twenty (20) hours per			
6	week;
