## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The purpose of the resolution is to set a public hearing to approve the Service Plans for two new metropolitan districts located in RiNo near 38<sup>th</sup> and Delganey.

The purpose of the metro district is to finance, construct and maintain public improvements supporting land uses containing residential and commercial.

State law requires notice of a public hearing on the Service Plan be at least 20 days prior to a public hearing which will be at City Council on September 17<sup>th</sup>. A presentation in Finance and Governance Committee is scheduled on August 28<sup>th</sup>.

The ordinance requesting to approve the Service Plan will promptly follow this resolution. Staff is asking for the resolution setting the public hearing date to pass out of committee on consent since the presentation will be conducted as part of the ordinance approving the service plan.
