6	<u>A BILL</u>

8	For an ordinance to amend the charter to give the legislative branch certain specified
9	powers currently reserved to the executive branch by giving the Denver city council the
10	authority to contract for professional services without executive branch approval, subject
11	to the approval of the voters at a special municipal election to be conducted in
12	coordination with the state general election on November 6, 2018.
13	
14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:
15	
16	Section 1. There is hereby submitted to the properly qualified and registered electors of the
17	City and County of Denver for their approval or rejection at a special municipal election to b
18	conducted at the same time and in conjunction with the general election to be held in the City and
19	County of Denver on November 6, 2018, a proposed amendment to the Charter of the City and
20	County of Denver, as follows:
21	
22	Effective upon publication and filing with the Secretary of State pursuant to the
23	Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado, the following sections of 2002
24	Charter of the City and County of Denver shall be and are hereby amended by
25	deleting the language stricken and adding the language underlined, to read as
26	follows:
27	
28	§ 3.2.10 – Independent professional services.
29	
30	(A) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the City Council as a whole may, from time to
31	time and without executive branch approval, contract for professional services that the City Counc
32	determines necessary to aid the City Council in carrying out its duties and responsibilities under thi

Charter and the Denver Revised Municipal Code. An individual contract entered into in accordance

1	with this section may not exceed an amount in excess of \$100,000.
2	(B) City Council shall develop and provide by ordinance the process by which this section may
3	be implemented for individual contracts.
4	
5	Section 2. The officials of the City and County of Denver charged with duties relating to the
6	election must, before the election, issue such calls, make such certifications and publications, give
7	such notices, make such appointments, and do all such other acts and things in connection with the
8	submission of this code amendment to the registered electors of the City and County of Denver at the
9	election required by the Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado and the Charter and
10	ordinances of the City and County of Denver.
11	
12	Section 3. The ballots cast at such election must be canvassed and the results
13	ascertained, determined, and certified in accordance with the requirements of the Constitution
14	and laws of the State of Colorado and the Charter and ordinances of the City and County of
15	Denver.
16	
17	Section 4. If any section, paragraph, clause, or other portion of this ordinance is held to
18	be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the validity of the remaining portions of this
19	ordinance shall not be affected.
