## A BILL

For an ordinance amending Section 18-51, Denver Revised Municipal Code, concerning the compensation of certain city employees who are not in the Career Service

WHEREAS, via a charter amendment adopted by the voters on November 5, 2013, the Manager of Aviation was granted the authority to appoint up to five employees to serve at the pleasure of the Manager, and excepted these employees from the Career Service; and

WHEREAS, Section 18-51, D.R.M.C. governing the compensation of certain employees not in the Career Service has not heretofore been amended to conform to the 2013 charter amendment.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER: <br> Section 1. That section 18-51, D.R.M.C. shall be amended by deleting the language stricken and adding the language underlined, to read as follows:

Sec. 18-51. - Applicability.

The provisions of this division 3 shall apply to the following employees not in the career service:
(m) Employees appointed to serve at the pleasure of the Manager of Aviation pursuant to Charter section 9.1.1 (E)(xv).
