Contract Name: Design Services Agreement between the City and FHU

The apparent low bidder for the construction of the Broadway, Arizona to Kentucky project is Castle Rock Construction. City staff needs continued support from the FHU consultant team to provide design support and materials testing during the construction of the project. The consultant team also needs to finish existing activities associated with the relocation and reestablishment of tenants and owners of the properties that were acquired for the project.

The contract with FHU will expire at the end of the year unless it is amended. City staff is requesting that Public Works Management approve moving forward with an amendment to the contract to add the additional services stated above, and provide a rate increase, for a second time, to the consultant team.

Listed below is the history of the contract:

- April 20, 2010 Original Contract for the 30% Design of the entire project
- March 21, 2012 Amendment 1 signed This Amendment added the Final design of Broadway and the Loop Ramp. An increase in rates of 2.25% was given. This matched the increase by City Employees after years of no raises and furloughs.
- Fall 2012 Amendment 2 Scope revision only. Swap in the final design of the Loop Ramp for Mississippi between the CML and Logan

An interoffice memo was issued on September 9, 2014 with the following guidelines for consultant rate increases to existing professional service contracts:

- 1. There will be no amendments for rate changes only.
- 2. Professional service contract rates may be modified/amended once per contract.
- 3. Rate changes should only be granted when the original contract term is extended and will only be considered on contracts that exceed three years in term.
- 4. Changes in hourly rates must not exceed a total of 5% of the aggregate original established contract rates for the term of the extension.
- 5. Reimbursables will not be considered for rate increases.

The memo does allow for a deviation from the above referenced guidelines will require approval by the City Engineer and CPM Director.

Guidelines 1, and 5 are met. City staff is requesting a deviation from guidelines 2, 3 and 4 from the CPM Director and the City Engineer. The justification is as follows:

- This contract has been going on for so long because it's taken years to piece together funding for the project. The contribution from Cherokee and Lionstone disappeared with the economic downturn in 2008. This is not the result of actions taken by the Consultant team.
- Refer to the history of the contract. This is the second time scope and term will be added to the
- It's been over three years since rates have been adjusted.
- The request from the consultant does not exceed a 5% increase to the current rates.
- Attached to this memorandum is FHU's request and supporting justification for a rate increase. City staff believes that the justification provided is valid.
- City staff has also looked at using existing on-call contracts with similar terms to complete this work. Upon comparing the rates for the on-call and those of the project specific contract with a 5% to the current rates, City staff determined that amending the rates within the contract provide a better value to the City. On average, the amended rates would be 2.4% less than those for the on-call.

For the above mentioned project, Felsburg Holt & Ullevig (FHU) is requesting to raise FHU's and subconsultant hourly rates by 5%.

Current project hourly rates lag our Standard Hourly Rates by an average of 9%, and our 2013 CDOT Master Pricing Agreement (MPA) by approximately 4%. (Note our 2014 CDOT MPA is about to be approved, and will increase the difference between our current CE93007 rates and CDOT MPA to approximately 5%.) See attachments for additional information.

Attached at the end of this document are the proposed rates for FHU and our subconsultants with the 5% increase.

Please let me know if the City will allow a 5% increase in hourly rates for FHU as well as our subconsultants. If not a 5% increase what percent increase will the City allow?

Once FHU receives written (or email) confirmation of the allowed rate increase FHU and our subconsultants will prepare a proposed fee estimate for Amendment 3, which covers engineering assistance during construction as well as material's testing.
