This agreement allows the City of Denver to construct, maintain, and operate a storm facility that crosses Union Pacific Property as part of the 33rd St. Outfall Project - Mountain Cement to Blake Street (31st and 33rd St. Outfall Project). A one-time payment of \$400,000 by the City of Denver is part of this agreement. The intent of the project is to construct a large storm facility (120" diameter pipe) along the basic alignment of 33rd Street from Arkins Ct. to approximately Downing St
