To date, staff has received 62 comment letters on the map amendment. Fifty-seven of the letters came in before the application was amended to a less intense zone district. Of those 57 letters 49 opposed the rezoning and 4 supported it. After the application was amended to the G-RH-3 zone district we received 8 letters, 3 letters support the rezoning and 5 oppose. Among the 5 that oppose is the Hilltop Civic Association.LVD
