EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The purpose of the ordinance is to approve a temporary ownership transfer of land contained in the initial boundaries of three 9th Avenue Metropolitan Districts. Ownership in the land was given to the City inadvertently as part of the site planning process before additional non-city owned land was included into each district's boundary. Typically the land in the initial boundaries is owned by the entity developing the site and in this case it was 9th Avenue Land LLC.

The transfer of land to the city then disqualified the existing board of directors from taking appropriate action to include non-city owned land into each district's boundaries. It is in the City's interests to enable the metro districts to be operative to assist in construction of needed infrastructure for the former CU Health Sciences Center site.

The approval of the transfer back to the development entity also comes with an escrow agreement where the development entity will execute a deed to the City to be held by the title company, so that the City is assured that the 33 square feet of land will come back to the City to be part of a city owned pedestrian walkway along 11th Avenue.
