12	Section 1. Upon consideration of the rec	ommendation of the Manager of Public Works that		
13	an ordinance be enacted for the purpose of as	ssessing the annual costs of the continuing care,		
14	operation, repair, maintenance and replacement	of the West 38th Avenue Phase I Pedestrian Mall		
15	Local Maintenance District ("West 38th Avenue	Phase I Pedestrian Mall"), for the upcoming year,		
16	upon the real property, exclusive of improvemen	ts thereon, benefited, the Council finds, as follows:		
17	(a) A local maintenance district prov	riding for the continuing care, operation, repair,		

maintenance and replacement of the West 38th Avenue Phase I Pedestrian Mall, was created by
Ordinance No. 653, Series of 1998;

(b) The annual cost of the continuing care, operation, repair, maintenance and
 replacement of the West 38th Avenue Phase I Pedestrian Mall is \$20,000.00, which amount the
 Manager of Public Works has the authority to expend for the purposes stated herein;

(c) The Manager of Public Works has complied with all provisions of law relating to the
publishing of notice to the owners of real properties to be assessed and to all persons interested
generally, and the Council sitting as a Board of Equalization has heard and determined all written
complaints and objections, if any, filed with the Manager of Public Works;

(d) The real property within the West 38th Avenue Phase I Pedestrian Mall will be benefited
in an amount equal to or in excess of the amount to be assessed against said property because
of the continuing care, operation, repair, maintenance and replacement of said Pedestrian Mall.

30 **Section 2.** The annual cost of the continuing care, operation, repair, maintenance and 31 replacement of the West 38th Avenue Phase I Pedestrian Mall to be assessed against the real 32 properties, exclusive of improvements thereon, benefited are hereby approved.

33 **Section 3.** The annual costs of the continuing care, operation, repair, maintenance and 34 replacement of the West 38th Avenue Phase I Pedestrian Mall in the amount of \$20,000.00 are

- 1 hereby assessed against the real properties, exclusive of improvements thereon, within said local
- 2 maintenance district as follows:

Section 4. The assessments made pursuant hereto shall be a lien in the several amounts
 assessed against each lot or tract of land set forth in Section 3 herein, and such lien shall have the
 priority of the lien for local public improvement districts.

- Section 5. Without demand, said assessments as set forth in Section 3 herein, shall be due and payable on the first day of January of the year next following the year in which this assessing ordinance became effective, and said assessments shall become delinquent if not paid by the last day of February of the year next following the year in which this assessing ordinance became effective. A failure to pay said assessments as hereinabove set forth shall become a lien on the property subject to the assessment, and such lien may be sold by the City as provided by the Charter and ordinances of the City and County of Denver.
- Section 6. Any unspent revenue and revenue generated through investment shall be retained and credited to the West 38th Avenue Phase I Pedestrian Mall Local Maintenance District for future long term or program maintenance of the District.
