0	land use recommendations relating to the creation of the Downtown-Central Platte Valley-Auraria			
1	Transition, River, and Center (D-CPV-T, D-CPV-R, and D-CPV-C) zone districts; and			
2	WHEREAS, on the same night as the public hearing on this Ordinance, City Council will			
3	consider an amendment to Article VI, Chapter 27, D.R.M.C., to implement an incentive height system			
4	that would allow structures in the proposed D-CPV-T, D-CPV-R, and D-CPV-C zone districts to			
5	exceed base heights when certain affordable housing requirements are provided; and			
6	WHEREAS, the City Council has determined on the basis of evidence and testimony			
7	presented at the public hearing that amending the Denver Zoning Code as set forth herein is			
8	consistent with the City's adopted plans, furthers the public health, safety and general welfare, and			
9	will result in regulations and restrictions that are uniform within zone districts where residential uses			
0.	are permitted.			
1	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF			
2	DENVER:			
3	Section 1. The changes to the Denver Zoning Code set forth in Clerk File No. 2018-0532			
4	as filed with the Denver City Clerk on November 14, 2018, and available in the office and on the web			
5	page of City Council are hereby adopted and made an official part of the Denver Zoning Code. The			
6	changes create the Downtown-Central Platte Valley-Auraria Transition (D-CPV-T), Downtown			
.7	Central Platte Valley-Auraria-River (D-CPV-R), and Downtown-Central Platte Valley-Auraria Cente			
8	(D-CPV-C) zone districts and make such zone districts available to be applied through future map			
9	amendments.
