5. General description or background of proposed request: This On-Call Environmental Services Contract provides environmental remediation technical support and administrative environmental support necessary for the redevelopment efforts of the former Stapleton Airport and as-needed environmental support for DEN. This is the third amendment to the agreement to extend the term from six years to seven years, replace Exhibit C rate schedule, and to add \$450,000.00 to the Maximum Contract Liability for a new contract amount of \$2,150,000.00. This third amendment will allow Brown and Caldwell, Inc., to provide DEN with the necessary continuity of services to meet the redevelopment schedule and the contractual requirements of the Master Lease and Disposition Agreement (MLD). DEN, City and County of Denver, Stapleton Development Corporation and the Developer, Forest City Stapleton, have agreed to allow land purchases under the existing agreements through 2019. This will allow DEN to respond to any unknown environmental remediation issues as well as supporting the timely redevelopment effort at Stapleton by providing the necessary environmental statements required in the land transfer process. The Airport’s intent is to have a competitive selection for any future DEN related work.

Scope of work: The contract will provide on-call environmental services on an as-needed basis to the Department of Aviation for DEN and the former Stapleton Airport. Brown and Caldwell, Inc., will continue to provide professional consulting services in support of the planning, implementation, and coordination of environmental programs at DEN. Compliance and/or permitting support will be requested on an as-needed basis in the following areas: water quality, storm water, wastewater, air quality, site assessment and remediation, construction and/or demolition, storage tanks, oil pollution prevention (Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasure plan) and waste management.

Brown and Caldwell, Inc. will continue to support DEN for the ongoing redevelopment efforts for the former SIA site. Pending the last land transfer scheduled in 2018, the consultant will complete the compilation of reports for environmental, remediation, building demolition and property transfer efforts covering the duration of the Stapleton Redevelopment Program. The information will be in a user-friendly database for future environmental or legal inquiries. The consultant will also create the final documentation for DEN Legal to the Federal Aviation Administration for DEN’s contractual obligations to meet federal regulations related to the release of Federal interests in the SIA property. This contract is necessary to complete the last of the land sales at SIA through 2019. Rebidding would delay these sales significantly.

Addition obligations as necessary: Environmental remediation responsibilities and attainment of No Further Action (NFA) and/or No Action Determination (NAD) from the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, and Property transfer and Administration responsibilities.
