Continued DMV renewal card printing services until DMV, TS, DMO, are able to comply with CDOR – new DRIVES system data requirements while retaining CCD card design aspects. A new RFP will be solicited summer 2019 once specifications can be developed to meet the new system requirements, and DMV renewal card design elements can be decided and finalized.

7. Is there any controversy surrounding this ordinance? (Groups or individuals who may have concerns about it?) Please explain: State of Colorado Department of Revenue recently implemented the **DRIVES** centralized DMV records system. User agencies statewide are experiencing various challenges impacting revenue/ accurate records capture and data reporting

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requirements. Until system impacts can be stabilized, our Denver DMV needs to continue with the current printing provider to maintain continuity of services until system interface problems can be resolved.

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
