Proclamation No. 19-0031

Recognizing Scott Bolt for Excellent Service to his Community

WHEREAS, Godsgman resident Scott Bolt has taken an active role in his registered neighborhood association which is an integral part of the fabric of the city and plays a key role in the ongoing effort to make Denver a great place to live, work, and play;

WHEREAS, from 2004 to 2015, Scott Bolt served as the president of the Godsgman Neighborhood Association and when the Godsgman and Ruby Hill Neighborhood Associations merged in 2015 to form the Ruby Hill/Godsgman Neighborhood Association he became a co-president and served until 2018; and

WHEREAS, during his time as president of the Godsgman Neighborhood Association he was an active member representing Godsgman on various committees, city boards and countless community service projects; and

WHEREAS, Scott was a board member on Denver Parks and Recreation Committee where he helped make decisions regarding the proposed tiered membership pricing for the new Denver recreation centers that were being built; and

WHEREAS, Scott worked on the Ruby Hill Master plan, alcohol policy, and made sure that Ruby Hill was dedicated as an official Denver Park as an active member and voice for the community; and

WHEREAS, Scott realized that South Federal Boulevard is one of the most dangerous State Highways, he was involved on the many improvements on South Federal Boulevard from Regis University located in the area of West 54th Avenue to Denver Public School Lincoln High School located in the area West Iliff Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Scott created opportunities for his community to engage in the conversations around the Colorado Public Radio property rezoning, the design and construction of the Levitt Pavilion, the Grandoozy Music Festival at the Overland Golf Course, and has spent countless hours attending meetings, planning community clean ups, and more; and

WHEREAS, Scott, after serving as a crucial member and leader for the Godsgman/Ruby Hill Registered Neighborhood Association for over a decade, stepped away from his role as co-president in 2018.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That the Council of the City and County of Denver hereby thanks Scott Bolt for an amazing job in his service to Southwest Denver, the Godsgman and Ruby Hill communities and hereby congratulates him on his retirement as the co- president of the Ruby Hill Godsgman Neighborhood Association.
