11	WHEREAS, the Colorado Constitution and (Charter of the City and County of Denver		
12	prohibit the salaries of elected officials from being increased or decreased during a term of			
13	office; and			
14				
15	WHEREAS, section 9.2.2 of the charter requires the City Council to establish the			
16	salaries for the ensuing term of elected Charter officers after January 1 of each year in which a			
17	general city election will be held, but before the general election; and			
18				
19	WHEREAS, any increase in the salaries of elected officials is limited to the cumulative			
20	increase in the Denver-Boulder-Greeley CPI or the cumulative increase in the mean salary of			
21	employees in the Career Service, whichever is less; and			
22				
23	WHEREAS, the cumulative increase in the Denver-Aurora-Lakewood CPI during the			
24	period 2015 through 2018, inclusive, was 10.07%;	and

26	WHEREAS, as reported by the Office of Hum	an Resources, the cumulative increase in		
27	the mean salary of employees in the Career Service for the period 2015 through 2018,			
28	inclusive, was 12.67%, meaning that the annual sa	alaries of Denver elected officials cannot		
29	increase in excess of 10.07% during the next four-year term of the elected officials			
30	commencing July 15, 2019.

32	BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY	AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

34	Section 1. That section 18-81, D.R.M.C. is	amended by deleting the language stricken and		

adding the language underlined, to read as follows:

Sec. 18-81. Salaries.

In accordance with the limitations on the salaries of elected Charter officers as set forth in section 9.2.2 of the Charter, the council hereby fixes the annual salaries for the term beginning July 20, 2015, July 15, 2019, as follows:
